Highlights of Our School

Discovering the Difference...

- * Family owned and operated. Active on-site ownership overseeing the care of children every day.
- * Child to Staff ratios run an average of 20-40% below the state required minimums with five management staff members to ensure consistent leadership in the School through the day.
- * Lead Teachers are required to have or enrolled to get the minimum of a Child Development Associate Certification.
- * All Inclusive Tuitions. Baby foods, juices and cereals for the infants, weekly gymnastics for 18 months - five years old, two or three computer lab visits a week and five Spanish classes weekly for Sweet 250 thru Sweet 500, Whiz Kids music classes once a week for infants thru five years old. All school supplies, arts and crafts supplies, and field trips are included! ABC Mouse, Brain Waves, Smartboard Technology and enhanced Science, Art and Cooking classes are included as well. Diaper wipes are included for any age and all meals including breakfast, as well as all snacks are provided at no additional charge. Every enrolled family has free access to the internet viewing camera system for their classroom(s).
- * The Kids Kafe' serving nutritious family style meals and a Boo-Boo Room for when we "feel bad". Even a car seat closet for parent's use is available for convenience.
- * Classrooms are divided into six month age differences. No grouping of broad age ranges or incidental groupings allows us to have the most age appropriate atmosphere in the child care industry. Dedicated base staffing crews are assigned to each classroom to help provide consistency for students and familiarity for parents.
- * Educational excellence starts with a great curriculum and ours starts with our infants and carries on through twelve years old. Weekly themed lesson plans and daily progress reports help to reinforce the learning concepts and keep parents informed. Sign language is taught to our infants and toddlers to help better communicate with them to understand their needs. Interactive "Smart Board" technology using preschool software developed by Hatch, an educational software leader, for each classroom is included to use every day as part of the classroom schedule. Use of ABC Mouse with integrated Kids R Kids curriculum helps to connect learning concepts at school to home and allows each student to continue learning with mom and dad in a fun environment! Kids R Kids takes advantage of the way children learn through the use of the Brain Waves curriculum which connects the provision of the right learning environment to support neural pathways for language, social-emotional, cognitive, and physical development. Our commitment to education can be seen with the recognition of our AdvancEd accreditation, which is the single largest education accrediting body in the country from preschool through college.
- * State of the art sanitization using the Zono Sanitech Machine to provide a clean, safe and healthy environment for all students, staff, and parents.

Features...

- * Open spacious feel with glass walls everywhere possible. Two important reasons for this: a security reason, high visibility; a safety reason, should a teacher ever need help they can see other teachers easily. Even the closets have glass inserts for safety reasons.
- * Our school is situated with ample acreage with four separate age-appropriate playgrounds, providing the perfect spacious place to play that is safe and engaging. Shade covers providing protection from the sun and safe zone spaces under every piece of playground equipment. Featuring Synlawn surfacing on all preschool playgrounds providing the safest and cleanest environment for active play.
- * “Water parks” to cool off throughout the summer provide a place to splash and play with friends!
- * Professional transportation featuring 15 and 50 passenger school busses equipped with seat belts for school-age transportation and field trips with certified commercial drivers and aides that are also CPR/First Aid certified. All drivers are cell-phone equipped.
- * Telephones in every class for parents to be connected anytime to your classroom and staff and for the staff to communicate with the directors in the lobby of the school.

Programs and Policies

- * Tuitions are billed on a weekly basis, due on Friday for the upcoming week. Late fees are posted at the close of business on Mondays.
- * As we are not “open to the public” for drop in care, two days attendance constitutes a full week. Please understand, we staff everyday expecting all children to attend school. This policy helps us to maintain high standards for every classroom.
- * Medical situations are closely monitored and depending on the type and scope of illness, we can restrict the attendance of our children.
- * Parents and family are welcome to participate in any daily activity or special events. You are welcome to drop by the school at any time.
- * Children attending a part time program are welcome to extend the week if additional days are needed. Billing for those days will not exceed the five day program tuition. Part- time children do not have to hold specific days from week to week.
- * We reserve the right to discontinue care of any child that after a reasonable amount of time, cannot adapt to our programs and practices. As we do welcome special needs children, we do have to assess our ability to provide the appropriate amount of care.

Diaper wipes are provided also for all infants and toddlers. Whiz Kids Music visits once a week with musical instruments and songs that cultivate interest and love of music. Eighteen months and older children also have use of the back room, our "Gym" in the mornings during the school year for soft physical education and developing gross motor skills. All class supplies, sleeping mats, and linens are provided. Access to the internet camera system for the classroom enrolled in.

Tuition includes: Gymnastics by Gym Station once a week. Whiz Kids Music visits once a week with musical instruments and songs that cultivate interest and love of music. Breakfast, family style lunches and two snacks are provided. Diaper wipes provided for all children needing them. All class supplies, sleeping mats and linens are provided. For Sweet 350-400 there are: two visits a week to the Computer Lab (three visits for Sweet 450-Private Kindergarten) and five afternoons a week students have Spanish class in their rooms taught by an education specialist. Field trip costs are also included for all ages. Home access to ABC Mouse is provided as part of the weekly tuition. Access to the internet camera system for the classroom enrolled in.

About Our School-Age Program

- * All School Age programs are planned to be fun and engaging. During the school year, parents can designate their child to take time for homework in our Homework Club that sets aside 30 minutes of time for homework help Monday thru Thursday.
- * We transport our children in either our 15 or 50 passenger buses equipped with seat belts and driven by CDL certified drivers equipped with cell phones.
- * Our Gyms are equipped with various activities with learning stations as well as items such as X Box with limited play time (only "E" rated games are available).
- * School age children have a wide range of snacks ready for them when they arrive from school. Lunches are provided on early release days taking place before noon. During summer camp, full lunches and snacks are included for "in-house" days. On field trips, snacks are taken and a variety of sandwiches and condiments, with plenty of liquids to keep everyone hydrated. Depending on the destination, cook-outs with burgers and hotdogs are not uncommon.
- * All crafts, supplies, inside attractions and field trips are provided by Kids R Kids. There are no additional fees. Freshly cleaned Kids R Kids field trip shirts are provided anytime students are traveling away from the school in order to easily identify them as part of the group.
- * Bus and gym rules are covered with our school age children and enforced to ensure safety and fun for everyone.
- * School age children have use of the largest playground and covered patio space, weather permitting.

Please Read Carefully

At Kids R Kids we offer the availability of securing a program for your child in several different ways. If we are not able to set a firm start date for your child, we can put you on the “open waiting list”. At the time you turn in your waiting list information we will be able to tell you definitely when you can expect to start.

The most important factor that we ask of parents going on our waiting list is to please not use this as an “alternate plan” or an “in case of” scenario. This will do nothing but upset our plans for other families, because when we block off an opening, we traditionally will turn away several others for the same spot. So, please be sure as you can be that you want us to block off an enrollment spot for your child so we don’t end up turning away a family that could use that spot. Also, it is costly for you to cancel a firm enrollment, we have to make a waiting list deposit non-refundable, since it could take us longer than normal to fill that space, should you decide to not enroll. Below, you will see our policies regarding placement on the waiting lists.
